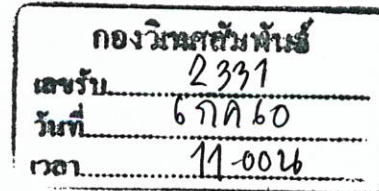

TUFS Short Stay Winter Program 2018

This four-week intensive program is aimed at learners of Japanese language who are currently enrolled in universities pursuing either an undergraduate or graduate degree. Our courses are designed to be practical ones providing the learners hands-on exposure to everyday Japanese language used in Japanese education, culture and society.

Classes will be divided according to the Japanese language proficiency of the participants and every class is designed to fulfill the needs of participants at different levels. Each class will consist of a small number of participants – 12 or less.

While supporting the participants to improve their Japanese language skills, this program will provide invaluable opportunities to experience the real Japan. This program includes various off-campus activities – a two-day excursion and culture trip(s) to Tokyo and Kanto regions to broaden the participants' understanding of Japanese culture. With the support from TUFS International Student Support Association, on-campus Japanese culture experience – tea ceremony, Kimono try-on, flower arrangement, calligraphy and interacting opportunities with TUFS Japanese students will also be offered.

Tokyo University of Foreign Studies

Founded over 100 years ago, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (TUFS) has been a stronghold for international scholarly research and a center for academic exchange in Japan. Over 600 international students from over 70 countries currently enrolled, TUFS is dedicated to creating and supporting a vibrant campus environment in which students with diverse backgrounds learn and grow together.

Our campus is located in Fuchu city in Tokyo surrounded by a lush green environment – within a short walking distance from Tama station on Seibu Tama Line and from Tobitakyu station on Keio Line. TUFS is easily accessible by train – Kichijoji, with a reputation to be a lively place for the young, is 20 minutes away, and Shinjuku, a sub center of Tokyo, 30 minutes away.

Japanese Language Center for International Students (JLC)

Japanese Language Center for International Students, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies (JLCTUFS) is one of the largest organizations for Japanese-language education in Japan and 2015 marked the 45th anniversary. In light of TUFS' grand plans, JLCTUFS has been working toward its goal to be a central hub for Japanese-language education in the world. Publishing textbooks for Japanese-language education and establishing and conducting research in Japanese-language education index, 'JLPTUFS Academic Japanese Can-do List', JLCTUFS supports and cooperates in Japanese-language education both in Japan and around the globe.

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Courses

Levels	3 levels (Pre-Intermediate・Intermediate・Advanced) – Classes will be divided according to the contents of application documents and results of the online Japanese-language proficiency test before the program starts.
Number of classes	TBA
Number of students in each class	Approximately 12
Eligibility	– Students currently enrolled in universities (either undergraduate or graduate level) – Having learned Japanese in high school or university, being able to write Hiragana and Katakana proficiently, and having completed an elementary level textbook(s). The admission priority is given to the students currently enrolled in our partner universities.
Total number of hours & credits	90 hours, 3 credits

[Pre-Intermediate]

This course is designed to improve the learners' basic communication skills and build a language learning foundation. The learners will practice dialogues in different situations using real life Japanese, and make a speech in easy Japanese, applying grammar and sentence patterns they had learned.

[Intermediate・Advanced]

These courses are designed to support the learners to acquire higher linguistic abilities – reading, writing, speaking and listening appropriate for each level. At both levels, the learners are expected to make oral and written expressions by actively using vocabulary and grammar they have learned so far. The learners will research in a given topic from the textbooks (collect information and conduct interviews with Japanese people) and present the results to the class. At **Intermediate Level**, the learners will be able to write short paragraphs to report what one has researched or thought of. At **Advance Level**, the learners will be able to speak about social and/or cultural issues, compare one's own country and others, and explain the findings from one's research using graphs or diagrams.

Study Trip & Japanese Culture Experience

Two-day excursion

The participants will visit major attractions and experience Japanese culture in Nikko, one of the UNESCO world heritage sites, in the outskirts of Tokyo.

Japanese culture experience

A tea ceremony, Kimono try-on, flower arrangement, calligraphy, home visit to Japanese families will be offered at low or no cost.

Certificate of Completion & Academic Records and Credits

A certificate of academic records will be issued to all participants. In addition, a certificate of completion will be issued to participants who maintain an attendance rate of 80% or higher and complete all assignments. Please ensure with home institutions whether the credits issued by TUFS, equivalent to 3 credits (90 hours of Japanese-language lessons + other compulsory lessons and activities + study trips), are transferable.

- If you wish to make any change in your application, you must request for change and confirm with us via e-mail. Changes after admission decisions may not be possible.

Scholarship

- Scholarship amount: JPY 80,000
- Number of recipients: TAB

Those who are enrolled in a degree program at a university engaged in an Academic Exchange Agreement with TUFS and wish to apply for the scholarship must fill out the scholarship related entries on e-apply. After comprehensive screening procedures, the results will be announced in late December.

When students are selected as a scholarship recipient, they must submit all required documents to TUFS upon completion of the program.

Program Fee

JPY 260,000

This includes the costs of application, tuition, accommodation (check-in: January 10, 2018, check-out: February 8, 2018), textbooks, and a two-day excursion.

Transportation, flight, overseas insurance, meals are not included.

Payment Method

Credit card payment only: the prospective student will be contacted via e-mail about the payment period and details. Admission will be cancelled if the payment is not received by the deadline (within one week after the admission notice was sent).

Accommodation

Accommodation will be prepared by TUFS. On-campus dormitory rooms will be allocated based on a first-come-first-served basis. You may have to commute to school by bus or train.

Withdrawal & Cancellation Policies

If an applicant withdraws by November 30, 2017, the full program fee will be refunded. If an applicant withdraws between December 1, 2017 and January 9, 2018, program fee minus accommodation fee will be refunded. TUFs will retain the full program fee of any applicant who withdraws after January 9, 2018. In every case of withdrawal, any and all transaction fee and credit card payment cancellation fee is to be paid by the applicant. In the event of cancellation of the program by Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, the total amount of the program fee will be refunded.

Overseas Travel Insurance

Applicants must properly insure themselves against the possibility of injury, illness or loss during their stay in Japan and travels to and from Japan. Tokyo University of Foreign Studies is not responsible nor will be held accountable for any injury, illness or loss incurred by the applicant in transit to, upon arrival in, and departure from Japan.

Visa to Enter Japan

It is the responsibility of applicants to obtain a visa to enter Japan if necessary. It may take weeks and require the applicants to submit additional documents before obtaining a visa. Please contact us no later than October 31 to request for a letter of acceptance and/or other required documents for a visa application. Apply for a visa at your nearest Embassy / Consulate General of Japan as soon as all the necessary documents are prepared.

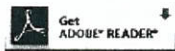
