



## 6. Introduction of Department

Departments	Introduction of Department
Mechanical Engineering	The Major of Mechanical Systems Engineering offers an advanced curriculum for professionals in the field of design and manufacturing of mechanical systems based on mechanics, control & automation, and manufacturing technologies.
Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning Engineering	The Major of Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineering offers an advanced curriculum for professionals in the field of design and manufacturing of refrigeration and air conditioning systems that are necessary to provide ultra-precision working conditions and comfortable residential environments in terms of temperature, humidity, and air purity.
Ocean Engineering	Making the ocean more accessible to use is essential for the growth of Korean industry and should be a national priority. The Department of Ocean Engineering provides education in the design and management of coastal and offshore structures that support ocean-going construction, coastal management and underwater resource development.
Logistics	Logistics management is that part of the supply chain which plans, implements and controls the efficient, effective forward and reverse flow and storage of goods, services and related information between the point of origin and the point of consumption in order to meet customers' requirements. Our department deals with various aspects of logistics such as Operations Research, Logistics Information, Freight Transportation Planning, Marketing, Distribution, Logistics Automation, Transportation & Logistics Planning, SCM strategy and Port Logistics etc
Control and Instrumentation Engineering	Factory and process automation is required to improve the productivity and business competitive power. To meet this requirement, the Department of Control and Instrumentation Engineering aims to cultivate specialized engineers leading the future industrial fields through multidisciplinary education in automation of industrial processes, sensor technology such as sensor fusion and image processing, computer networks, and AI technology etc. The department is organized by 7 faculty members dedicated to teaching and research activities. For the graduate course, the department offers study programs leading to the Master and Doctoral degrees in Control and Instrumentation Engineering
Marine Equipment Engineering	This department deals principally with the preparation, characterization and evaluation of new materials made from conventional metal, organic and inorganic materials. Students learn about advanced expert knowledge that can apply these materials to the marine field by utilizing various knowledge among the interdisciplinary fields. Training students to become engineers specializing in ship's equipment which is the core of the shipbuilding and marine industries.
Electrical and Electronics Engineering	Electrical & Electronics Engineering is a key sector of the civilization of modern science and technology, studying fundamental science and developing innovative technology. It requires a large number of technical professionals. Since it is an essential technology that forms the industrial information society in the 21st century, this sector demands many talented people.
Civil and Environmental Engineering	Civil Engineering is the study to plan, design, construct and maintain the natural and social infrastructures including bridges, roads, railways, airports, ports, dams, tunnels, and power plants. Environmental engineering is the high-tech study which is trying to solve various kinds of environmental problems caused by the modern development. The environmental quality is deemed to be a barometer of a country's quality of life and the demand for experts in the field is on the rise.
Computer Engineering	Computer engineering with information and communication technology is the core of the advanced society in the 21st century. As a result, all the organizations of the country, including the government, support education and research in computer and information engineering. The department provides courses on computer hardware and software such as artificial intelligence, speech recognition, database, natural language processing, multimedia, internet, and computer communication. It mainly focuses on producing highly trained computer and information researchers. They can lead advanced computer technologies in the next generation, and also make contributions to all computer-supported areas, such as management, design, and manufacturing.
ELECTRONIC MATERIALS ENGINEERING	Study on the design and application of various devices such as compound semiconductor electronic/optical-devices and sensors, based on the understanding of semiconductor physics.
Oceanic Architectural Engineering	The Department of Oceanic Architectural Engineering conducts practical work-oriented researches, and offers a major in Architectural Design and a major in Disaster Prevention of Offshore Structures. The major in Architectural Design is the first of its kind in Korea that is specialized in maritime construction. Students learn planning and design of all the possible environments in which people can live in contact with the sea. These include coastal, underwater and ocean floor spaces as well as water-friendly space. The major in Disaster Prevention of Offshore Structures concerns the construction of buildings to reside comfortably on the sea or land, safely and economically.



Naval Architecture and Ocean Systems Engineering	This major aims to develop world-class human resources in the field of ship building and related ocean industries. To accomplish this aim, the major covers beyond the basic knowledge of naval architecture such as design of vessels and off-shore structures to include techniques of shipbuilding and information technology. Laboratory facilities for education and research include a circulating water channel for testing hydrodynamic performance of ships, equipment for testing strength of structures, ship design center, equipment for testing vibration, equipment for welding dynamics and production, two-dimensional wave tank for testing offshore structures, and ship building CAD center.
Maritime Law & Policy	The maritime sector is a comprehensive area combining various fields based on sea and vessels. In order to master maritime power, it is necessary to establish systematic maritime policy through in-depth interdisciplinary research in this field. Our Department of Maritime Law and Policy is leading the 21st century with comprehensive interdisciplinary research that fosters international maritime specialists through an interdisciplinary convergence between maritime law and maritime policy areas. The Maritime Law Major covers maritime laws, the law of the sea, maritime commercial law, maritime criminal law, maritime traffic law, maritime administrative law, maritime labor law, etc. The Maritime Policy Major covers shipping, port policy, maritime safety and security policy, marine environmental policy, marine resources management policy, fisheries policy, etc.
Advanced Ship Management Convergence	As the world's seventh largest shipping country and the world's No. 1 shipbuilding country, Republic of Korea has an advantageous environment and conditions for the ship management industry to grow and develop. SM industry is rapidly evolving with globalization, large scale, convergence, eco-friendly, and advanced technology. In the near future, major changes in the size of the market and business area are expected due to the emergence of autonomous vessels based on artificial intelligence (AI). In response, the Department of Advanced Ship Management Convergence is a graduate course that trains Super-Intendant(SI) who can manage future high-tech ships with the world's highest efficiency and service, and has Advanced Ship Operations Management major and Advanced Ship Technology Management major.
Convergence Study on the Ocean Science and Technology	This joint degree program is between Korea Maritime and Ocean University and Korea Institute of Ocean Science and Technology, including degrees in M.S. and Ph.D. This graduate program specialized in ocean-related science and technology. * 'M.S. and Ph.D. in Engineering is possible.'
Convergence Education of Maritime & Ocean Culture-Contents	To train experts in marine cultural content convergence who will lead the 21st century's new marine era through creative and practical specialized education based on the convergence of humanities and space
Data Informatics	The Department of Data Informatics offers a program of graduate study in big data analytics, statistics, and computer science as well as mathematics.
Marine Bioscience and Environment	The Department of Marine Bioscience and Environment was established to promote research and education in the understanding, management, and development of ocean environment and resources for the harmonious coexistence of humans and the environment. There are two majors in our department: Major in Marine Environmental Science, Major in Marine Biotechnology. Marine Environmental Science studies the natural characteristics of the ocean proper to understand how best to preserve and utilize the ocean environment. Marine Biotechnology applies biology and chemistry to the study of how to nurture and employ marine organisms. It also aims to prepare students for careers in various bio-industries.
Shipping Management	The Department of Shipping Management Graduate School, which was established in 1984, provides all graduate students with advanced theoretical and practical knowledge on maritime business such as shipping, port, shipping information and maritime finance. We also support and encourage the students both to publish research papers in well-known academic journals and to write their dissertations in the field of maritime industry with advanced research methods. The objective of the course is to educate scholars and experts who will be engaged in maritime related academia and research institutes and business. The curriculum consists of not only specialized subjects on maritime industry but also business administration.
Maritime law	The Department of Maritime law aims to train legal professionals of law in the various modern laws by studying examples and theories of professional law-related information. It allows students to master various fields of law in three majors: major in Public law, major in Private law, major in maritime law
International Trade	The department focuses on offering the subjects to understanding the world economy and to search the policy for improvement of efficient resource allocation of world economy. Three majors-economics, international trade and maritime economics- will be offered
English Language and Literature	The Graduate Program in the Department of English Language and Literature at Korea Maritime & Ocean University offers both MA and Ph.D in the areas of Linguistics, TESOL and British/American Literature. The graduate program focuses on specialized teaching and research for professional and academic jobs. Students are encouraged to explore their own areas of interest with a faculty of active researchers and educators. The department offers a range of courses in Linguistics, Teaching of English to Speakers of Other Languages, and British and American literature. Our department especially offers some specialized courses such as Maritime English and Maritime Literature and Maritime Corpus Linguistics designed to help students become an expert in the field of Maritime affairs and business. The department aims to prepare students for independent work as scholars and educators by developing their ability to raise/inquire about problems in studies of English Language and Literature. Currently, there are graduate students in the program from other countries such as China, USA, and Uzbekistan.
International Area & Cultural Studies	Beyond the nation-state, East Asia and Europe are the regional units. Also, keep in mind the local, which is a smaller unit than the state. Through this, we aim to foster experts who study the formation of new regions and their culture.



## 2021 Global Korea Scholarship for Graduate Degrees: FAQ

<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	
<b>Q1</b>	I am currently enrolled at a university in Korea pursuing Master's degree. Am I eligible to apply for the Master's degree program under GKS?
<b>A1</b>	Yes, you are eligible to apply for our scholarship program if you have not graduated from a Korean high school or university. Those who have previously studied in a Korean university as an exchange or visiting students can also apply if a degree certificate (or diploma) was not issued. However, if you are selected as our GKS scholar, you must drop out of the university you are currently enrolled at and start the degree program under GKS as a first year. The transfer of credits from your previous university is not possible.
<b>Q2</b>	I am in the last semester at one of the Korean universities for a Bachelor's (Master's) degree program and am expected to attain degree soon. Am I eligible to apply for a Master's (Doctoral) degree under GKS?
<b>A2</b>	No, you are not. If you are classified as a student who is expected to attain your Bachelor's (Master's) degree in Korea, you are not eligible to apply for a Master's (Doctoral) degree program under GKS. However, if you are an Overseas Korean adoptee or a previous GKS scholar who is expected to or have already attained a degree in Korea, you may apply for a GKS Graduate degree. Previous GKS scholars can reapply for a higher degree only once.
<b>Q3</b>	I am expected to complete my Bachelor's (Master's) degree in August 2021. Am I eligible to apply for a Master's (Doctoral) degree program under this scholarship?
<b>A3</b>	If you submit an official certificate of expected graduation or a provisional degree certificate issued by the university, you may apply for the 2021 GKS. However, it is only permitted under the condition that you will submit your final degree certificate and final academic transcript to NIIED by August 31, 2021. The failure of doing so will result in the cancelation of the scholarship.



Q4	My parents and I hold different citizenships. Am I eligible to apply for the program?
A4	Yes you may. If you hold a citizenship of NIIED designated countries that are invited to take part in our Global Korea Scholarship program AND if your parents do not hold Korean citizenship, you are eligible to apply for our program.
Q5	I meet all the application requirements listed in the GKS-G application guidelines. Does this mean that I am qualified to apply to all GKS partner universities?
A5	<p>Not really. The application requirements we have indicated in our GKS-G application guidelines are the minimum requirements to apply for our Global Korea Scholarship. However, some universities and departments may require a certain level of language proficiency, research experience and other qualifications. Therefore, we ask all prospective applicants to go through “University information” file posted with our application guidelines to check if they should meet further requirements.</p> <p>If the university requests supplementary document(s) beyond NIIED’s required documents, you should submit those materials directly to the university.</p>
<b>APPLICATION SUBMISSION</b>	
Q6	May I apply for the program by submitting my application to NIIED directly?
A6	<p>No, you may not. Applications must apply and submit their application documents to a Korean Embassy where they hold citizenship or directly to one of partner universities. For any inquiries regarding submission guidelines, please refer to the application guidelines or check with the embassies and universities where the first round of selection is conducted since each institute may have different application submission guidelines.</p> <p>Even if you are currently residing in Korea or in a different country and you are to apply via embassy track, you must submit your application documents to the Korean embassy in the country where you hold citizenship.</p>



Q7	When is the deadline for the application?
A7	Each institute (Korean embassy or university) where first round of selection is conducted decides its own deadline. You must check with the Korean embassy in your home country or your desired university regarding exact application deadline.
Q8	Where can I submit my application? Is online submission available?
A8	<p>No, we do not have online application system.</p> <p>All applicants must submit their application documents in hard copies to the institutes that conduct the first round of selection. For GKS-Graduate degrees, you can submit your application documents either to the Korean embassies or Korean universities.</p> <p>Before submitting your application documents, you must carefully read through the 2021 GKS-G Application Guidelines, available on Study in Korea website (<a href="http://www.studyinkorea.go.kr">www.studyinkorea.go.kr</a> &lt; Scholarships &lt; GKS Notice board).</p>
Q9	Must I submit the certificates of language proficiency (English or Korean) when I apply for GKS?
A9	<p>The certificate of English proficiency (TOEIC, TOEFL or IELTS) or Korean proficiency (TOPIK) is an optional document, which means you may apply for GKS without it. However, if you are an applicant of highly competitive country, Korean embassy or Korean university may require a certain level of language proficiency.</p> <p>For your reference, if you hold a TOPIK level 3 or above, you will be given additional points. If you submit your certificates of English proficiency, you may be given preference based on your test scores.</p>



Q10	What should I put in the section of GPA on the Application Form?
A10	<p>Please put your GPA or score percentile for each semester. If you have completed your undergraduate program with 8 semesters for 4 years, fill in the blanks with your GPA <b>or</b> score percentile for each semester.</p> <p>Write your GPA or score you have received in front of the slash (/) and write a full GPA or full marks behind the slash (/).</p> <p>For example, if your GPA is 3.5 out of 4.5, you must indicate it as 3.5/4.5. If your percentage is 85 out of 100, indicate it as 85/100.</p> <p>If you had completed more than three semesters per year, you may add additional columns to the term or semester section.</p>
Q11	How many recommendation letters should I submit? For embassy track applicants, we must submit one original and three copies. How do we make copies of the sealed recommendation letters?
A11	<p>NIIED requires applicants to get recommendation letters from TWO different recommenders.</p> <p>For embassy track applicants, as recommendation letters cannot be opened by the applicant, you should ask each of your recommender to first write one original recommendation letter. Each recommender should make three identical copies of the original recommendation letter, sign each letter, and seal them all together in an envelope and sign across the back flap of the envelope. Thus, a sealed envelope containing 4 identical recommendation letters should be submitted per recommender.</p> <p>For university track applicants, you should collect one original recommendation letter from each recommender.</p>
Q12	I am planning to apply for 2021 GKS-G and I have already received a recommendation letter from my university's professor in March 2020. Can I submit this recommendation letter?



A12	<p>The recommendation letter should be dated within a year from the very last date of the application deadline.</p> <p>Therefore, if your recommendation letter was issued more than a year from the 2021 GKS-G application submission deadline (set by each Korean embassy or university), you cannot submit that recommendation letter.</p>
Q13	<p>Should I include a detailed research proposal in the Statement of Purpose?</p>
A13	<p>Yes. You must at least describe the general direction and outlines of your study plans, if not in full detail. Please elaborate on your study objectives in Korea, tangible plans during and after you complete the degree program.</p>
Q14	<p>I will apply through the embassy track. According to the guidelines, I should submit 4 sets of application documents: 1 original document and 3 photocopies. How do I submit my certificates such as transcripts, graduation certificates or recommendation letters?</p>
A14	<p>All certificates must be presented in their original forms. For example, ask your university to issue you four sets of transcripts and four sets of degree certificates. However, if you must submit photocopied documents because the original document cannot be reissued again, you should submit authenticated (notarized, apostilled, or consular confirmed) documents in lieu of original documents. Then, make three more sets of copies of the authenticated documents.</p> <p>For recommendation letter, please refer to Q&amp;A 11 in this FAQ.</p>
Q15	<p>How do I submit my documents written in a language other than Korean or English?</p>



A15	Documents written in languages other than Korean or English must accompany a complete Korean or English translation notarized by a notary public.
Q16	I am a Japanese citizen, currently living in Vietnam. May I apply for the program through the Korean Embassy in Vietnam?
A16	<p>No, you may not. If you choose to apply through the embassy track, you must submit your application to the Korean Embassy in Japan.</p> <p>Embassy track applicants must submit your application documents to the Korean embassy in the country where you hold the citizenship.</p> <p>In addition, if you hold the citizenship of a country that is not invited to take part in GKS-G, you are not eligible to apply for GKS.</p>
Q17	I am a Chinese citizen. In the application guidelines, there is quota only assigned in the embassy track for the Chinese citizens. Does that mean that I must apply to the Korean Embassy in China?
A17	<p>No, if you are a Chinese citizen, you should not submit your application to the Korean Embassy in China. According to the mutual agreement between Korea and China, Chinese applicants must submit their applications to China Scholarship Council (CSC) under the Ministry of Education in China.</p> <p>※ Likewise, a Czech citizen must also submit his or her application to the Ministry of Education in Czech Republic, in accordance with the mutual agreement between the governments of Korea and Czech Republic.</p>
Q18	I am American living in Los Angeles, United States. I am going to apply for the program via the Korea Embassy. Should I submit my application to the Embassy in Washington D.C.?

NIIED strongly recommends that you contact the universities to consult on the majors and degree programs you are interested in.</p>
Q20	<p>How many majors and universities can I apply for admission?</p>
A20	<p>If you apply through the <b>university track</b>, you may choose only ONE university and ONE major offered for GKS.          If you apply through the <b>embassy track</b>, you may choose THREE universities under Type A and B. Please remember that at least one of your three choices has to be chosen from Type B universities.          Note that you may choose the same major for all three universities. For your reference, there are country quota in the university track, and part of the quota is reserved for natural science and engineering majors applying to regional universities. Q22	I am going to apply for the program via embassy track. According to the application guidelines, applicants should choose up to 3 preferred universities and departments (or majors). Are there tips on choosing those universities and majors?
A22	<p>Embassy track applicants should understand that passing the second round of selection will not guarantee an admission to the university that you have chosen. There are cases with Embassy track applicants who fail to be selected from all three universities if they choose among highly competitive universities. Each Korean university has recognition for variety of fields and has its own strength. Please conduct your own research to find out which university is the leading institution in the field of study you would like to pursue.</p>
Q23	I am an embassy track applicant. I am aware that I have to choose at least one university from Type B universities. Does this mean that I can only choose one university from Type B?
A23	No. You can choose <u>at least</u> one university from Type B. In other words, your all three choices may not be chosen just from Type A. However, should you wish, your all three choices can be chosen from Type B.



## KOREAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

Q24

Is it mandatory for all GKS scholars to pass at least Level 3 in TOPIK after one year of Korean Language Course?

A24

Yes, it is. Every GKS scholar must get at least Level 3 on TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) within a yearlong Korean language program in order to proceed to his or her degree program.  
Please note that NIIED assigns Korean language institution for each GKS scholar with various factors in consideration. The scholars cannot change their assigned language institutions. During the language program, scholars are required to live on-campus and accompanying family members is not allowed.

Q25

May I be exempt from the Korean Language Program?

A25

If you have already attained advanced level (Level 5 or 6) on TOPIK when applying for the program, you are exempt from Korean language program and you must directly start your degree program from September, 2021.  
Applicants who attained TOPIK level 5 or 6 after the initial application deadline must submit the valid TOPIK certificate to NIIED by Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021.  
(\*The 75<sup>th</sup> TOPIK score is the last TOPIK score one should report to NIIED for exemption from the Korean language program.)  
If you attain TOPIK level 5 or 6 during the first 6 months of Korean language program, you will be exempt from the remaining 6-month language training and you must start your degree program in the following semester (March, 2022).



## DEGREE PROGRAM

Q26	May I change my final choice of a university for a graduate degree during the preliminary Korean language course?
A26	No, you may not. Changing the university or transferring to another university is NOT PERMITTED under any circumstances. Changing a major is also not allowed unless there is a structural change in your department or major. However, the procedure for changing a major is extremely complicated so we ask all applicants to obtain sufficient information about your desired university and major before applying.
Q27	What if I do not attain degree within the scholarship period? Can I extend my scholarship period until I graduate?
A27	Even if you do not attain degree within the scholarship period NIIED has designated, once your initial scholarship period is over, your scholarship benefits will come to an end. The extension of scholarship period is strictly forbidden.
